

### **GDP Growth in Kazakhstan**




#### **GDP Annual Growth, USD bn.**










#### **Structure of Issuers in the Official List**






#### **Trading Volume, USD mln**






#### **Equity Market Capitalization, USD bn**




### **Corporate Bonds**





Volume of Outstanding Corporate Debt, USD bn












#### **Public Debt Redemption, KZT trln**





**Trading volume, USD bn** 




Repo market instruments 9M 2021, USD bn






### Growth in the Number of Retail Investors:


